Double-walled DuraFlex lids were first introduced in 1993 to replace brittle vacuum formed plastic and fibre glass lids, which often broke after a short service life. Durable and attractive in appearance, DuraFlex lids have re-set the quality benchmark which the waste industry demands.

The range now covers all sizes from 660 litre up to 1700 litre. The most popular size alone, 1100 litre, comprises five different models, both British and Continental format. All lids are designed to permit compliance of the bin with the European norms EN840.

Recycling lids are available in 770 litre, 1100 litre, 1280 litre and 1700 litre sizes, with a choice of apertures covered by hoods, flaps, brushes, or rubber diaphragms, to facilitate the segregation of recovered fractions at source.

DuraFlex Front End Loader (FEL) Lids

A key factor in Container Components Europe's growth during the 1990's was the implantation of American contractors and the introduction/expansion of the front end loader waste collection system.

We adapted the original American designed lids to suit the pitched-top containers predominant in Europe. A full range of conventional top-hinged lids in widths from 900-935mm is available. For German systems built according to DIN norms, lids in W=835mm can also be supplied. The latest version incorporates an overlap and rain channel, to keep the container watertight.

In certain markets, notably Scandinavia, side-hinged lids are proving increasingly popular. The lids can readily be propped open, permitting hands-free charging of the container. Side-hinged lids are less susceptible to damage, because they do not enter as deep into the feed hopper of the FEL vehicle.

DuraFlex Rear End Loader (REL) Lids





- Lightweight and safe
- User-friendly, eliminating spring mechanisms (Eurobin lids)

There are two distinctive styles of REL containers used in Europe.

UK/Scandinavia:

Lids are available in W=1737mm and 1775mm, and in different lengths to cover openings up to 2140mm long. The series 70 has a double-hinged joint between the two sections, so that the front lid can be tipped open independently. New developments focus on the provision of watertight lids.

Germany/Benelux/France:

The German style container is also used extensively in neighbouring countries. DuraFlex lids for Eurobins started to displace metal lids in 1994, enabling users to dispense with spring-loaded lid opening devices. Two models exist, the more recent one incorporating a moulded-in handle.

From a single mould, which typically costs about £10,000, Container Components Europe are capable of producing approximately 7000 parts per annum. The economies of scale and inherent flexibility make rotomoulding the ideal medium for modest production runs. We are happy to consider any project which will generate upwards of 1500 parts per annum.



This enables us to supply most UK orders ex-stock, the same day on a 72 hour service provided by a common carrier. 48 hour and next day delivery is available at a small surcharge.

For export orders, we have negotiated competitive freight rates with a large number of international road haulers. Although we regularly ship full truck loads to over 10 different locations, quantities of 50 lids and over can also be delivered cost-effectively and efficiently by road anywhere in Europe. Destinations in the Baltic, Middle East and Africa are most likely to be dealt with by a sea container service. We systematically obtain freight quotations from at least three haulers to guarantee our customers optimal performance and economy of delivery.
